Scope, Aims, Methods, and Initial Literature: Direct electrification refers to ways and devices providing heat and road transport while directly using electricity as an input (e.g., electric heaters, electric heat pumps, battery electric vehicles, battery-fuelled mileage of plug-in hybrids, trolley vehicles) (Madeddu et al., 2020; Philibert, 2019; Ruhnau et al., 2019; Ueckerdt et al., 2021). Taking a strategic technology management perspective (Christensen, 1992a, 1992b; Hård & Knie, 2001; Huarng, 2010; Schilling & Esmundo, 2009), this thesis aims to

- map and specify (comparative dimensions) the drivers of direct electrification
- map and specify (comparative dimensions) the barriers of direct electrification
- map and specify (comparative dimensions) from startups and incumbents

Insights from 1) a systematic review of the scientific literature (Denyer & Tranfield, 2009), 2) selected grey literature (Adams et al., 2017), as well as 3) expert interviews (Cassell, 2009) should be combined.
